## Costume Instructions

***Welcome to Encore Theater Camp! It's time to get dressed! Be sure you read ALL instructions. If you have any questions, feel free to reach out to me.***

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### ***General Info***

Costuming at WFA is a partnership with parents. During camp week campers will construct a shirt and accessories for their costumes out of materials that WFA provides. At the end of the Friday night performance, you get to keep all pieces of your costume. Campers will be required to provide a base costume for us to build on. See below for your camper's base costume requirements and other important info.

### **IMPORTANT:**

- Campers must come to camp **on Friday performance ready** for dress rehearsal. This includes wearing their base costume, hair, and makeup. They will return for the performance this way as well.
- Do not bring your base costume to camp before Friday unless you have concerns that need to be addressed by the costume department.
- Base pieces do not have to be new items. They may be from your closet or even thrift stores (my personal favorite places). Items will NOT be damaged or altered for the performance.
- Hair and makeup enhancements will be done on your child during camp on Friday. Please do your best to protect this look between camp and the performance call time.
- If you feel that you will need support to create the hair and makeup look required, please email me ASAP. We have volunteers that can help if needed.
- If your child has a lead role then your base costume may be minimal and WFA may provide most of their costume. You will not be able to keep the pieces provided by WFA unless approved by the Costume Director. If you feel that you have items in your closet that might work for your costume, please let me know as soon as possible.

### ***Camp Neverland***

This group will perform as a group of modern children imagining neverland. They will be able to choose their role as a lost kid, pirate, or Indian brave and make accessories to help them pretend that role.

- ***Base Costume*** – Your favorite NON-LOGO play clothes, non-light up, closed-toed shoes, and socks (optional). This may be in the form of a shirt with pants/shorts/skirt or a casual dress. If you wear a skirt you must wear bike shorts under and the skirt must go to your fingertips. Please pick solid colors or simple patterns such as polka dots or stripes in primary or secondary colors. Pastels are ok. NO flip flops or neon colors please.
- ***Hair & Makeup*** – Hair will need to be styled simply to allow for hats and headbands. Girls with long hair will need to have hair pinned or pulled back from their faces. Natural looking stage makeup is optional for girls.

### ***Camp Fly***

This group will perform as Peter's shadow while he flies over London.

- ***Base Costume*** – Any color tank top or cami, black leggings or joggers, black socks, black close-toed shoes (solid black only, no white accents).
- ***Hair & Makeup*** – Girls will need a low bun. Boys will need a simple combed hair style. Natural make up is optional.

### ***Camp Pan***

This group will perform as Lost Boys and Girls. They all ran away from their London schools chasing peter's promise of never growing up. They will look like private school children who have accessorized their looks with the resources nature has provided them. Of course, with out a mother, they look a bit wild! Photo inspiration will be posted on the Everything Encore webpage.

- ***Base Costume*** – White tank top or cami, khaki shorts or skirt, white socks, brown/nude dress shoes. \*Please note, skirts must be as long as the wearers fingertips and be accompanied with appropriate undershorts. Think uniform bottoms. They do not need to be ripped up or dirty.
- ***Hair & Makeup*** - Lost children have wild hair after a long day of playing in the woods. Girls will need to have hair pulled back from their faces in a half or full ponytail or teased away from their faces. Feel free to curl and comb it into a pretty do, then tease and mess it up like crazy! Boys should aim for a just-out-of-bed look. We will be adding hats and headbands, so be sure to ask your camper what accessories they have designed for their costume after the first day. Natural looking stage makeup with natural colored lipstick is optional. All Lost children will have face paint added during

### ***Camp Ugh-a-wog (Lost Boys & Girls Only)***

This group will perform as Lost Boys and Girls. They all ran away from their London schools chasing Peter’s promise of never growing up. They will look like private school children who have accessorized their looks with the resources nature has provided them. Of course, without a mother, they look a bit wild! Photo inspiration will be posted on the Everything Encore webpage. **\*\* If you are listed in this group but are a brave girl dancer, see Camp Brave below.**

- ***Base Costume*** – White tank top or cami, khaki shorts or skirt, white socks, brown/nude dress shoes. \*Please note, skirts must be as long as the wearers fingertips and be accompanied with appropriate undershorts. Think uniform bottoms. They do not need to be ripped up or dirty.
- ***Hair & Makeup*** - Lost children have wild hair after a long day of playing in the woods. Girls will need to have hair pulled back from their faces in a half or full ponytail or teased away from their faces. Feel free to curl and comb it into a pretty do, then tease and mess it up like crazy! Boys should aim for a just-out-of-bed look. ### ***Camp Brave & Camp Ugh-A-Wug Featured Dancers (Jr. & Sr. Featured Dancers)***

Tiger Lily’s BFF’s are not stereotypical American Indian girls. They are wild, free, fearless warriors of Neverland . . .most of the time. Oh, and they love to DANCE!

- ***Base Costume*** – Nude/beige Tank top or cami, nude/beige leggings (NOT TIGHTS), no shoes. **These items will be VISIBLE under your costume**, so wear appropriate undergarments as well. You may wear slip on shoes to travel in, but you will be dancing barefoot.
- ***Hair & Makeup*** – Crazy, wild, BIG hair and the creative use of braids will be your theme when choosing a hairstyle. Hair must be pulled back or braided away from your face, but may be mostly down if you choose. Remember to consider the hair accessories you make at camp. Wear natural looking stage makeup with natural colored lipstick. A face paint design of your choosing and spot hair color will be applied to you at camp on Friday. Please do not remove this paint effect before their performance. Photo inspiration will be posted on the Everything Encore Page.

## **Camp Hook**

They are big, bad, punk-rock pirates and Hook's right hand (or hook) men! Think 80's or 90's punk rock band or vikings for inspiration. Photo inspiration will be posted on the Everything Encore webpage.

- Base Costume – White tank top or cami, black bottoms, black shoes/boots. As the oldest (and most fashion savvy) group, you have a lot of creative freedom in the term “black bottoms”. This could be black shorts, joggers, ripped jeans, leggings, or skirt with cool tights or fishnets. Your only guidelines are that they must be 1) solid black without any pattern or design, 2) skirts and shorts must go to your fingertips, 3) the costume top you design must cover your behind if you choose leggings.
- Hair & Makeup - Twists, spikes, bobby pin designs, a teasing comb and a TON of hairspray will be your tools for this hairstyle. Girls may use twists but NOT braids of any kind. BIG hair is GOOD! Boys can paste your hair into spikes or gel your hair for that just-out-of-bed look. You may use natural looking stage makeup, however, don't be afraid of heavy eyeliner or red lipstick. A face paint design of your choice and hair color may be added during camp on Friday.

## **Principle Roles**

Peter – black tank top, black bike shorts, black jazz shoes or plain sneakers. Hair may be styled to have a just-out-of-bed look, however it will need to be away from your face and eyes. You will be wearing a hat.

Twins 1 & 2, Slightly, Curley, Tootles, Mack, Cece – See Camp Pan instructions.

Hook, Smee, Noodler, Jukes, Starkey, Cecco – See Camp Hook instructions.

Tick Tock – Costume Director will reach out to you.

Tiger Lily, Brave Girl 1 & 2 – See Camp Brave instructions. Costume Director will reach out to Tiger Lily about hair.

Wendy – White or nude cami and undershorts, white satin slippers or ballet flats. I believe Walmart sells white satin slippers. Hair should be pulled back into a half or full ponytail and curled. Natural looking stage makeup.

Mrs. Darling, Liza – White or nude cami & undershorts, black flats or heeled character shoes. Hair should be done up in the Gibson-girl style. Natural looking stage makeup.

Mr. Darling – White dress shirt, black flat-front dress slacks, black dress shoes. Pomaded hair in an Edwardian style.

John & Michael – White tank top, black athletic shorts. Costume Director will reach out to you about shoes. Natural to slightly mussed hair.
